Other Business

A. Public Comment Session

There were no public comments.

B. To consider approval of a resolution authorizing up to \$50,000,000 in an economic incentive package from the Economic Development Project Fund to support a project in Weirton, West Virginia as a High Impact Development Project.

Whereas, the board determined that the public purpose of the West Virginia Economic Development Authority Act would be met by a forgivable performance loan in the amount of \$50,000,000 to Cleveland-Cliffs Weirton LLC.

Whereas, a motion was made by Ms. Olejasz to approve the Governor's request for a forgivable performance-based loan pursuant to the provisions of W.Va. Code §31-15-23a in an amount of up to \$50,000,000 to Cleveland-Cliffs Weirton LLC. The following motion was seconded by Mr. Wilmoth and was carried.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That a forgivable performance-based loan by WVEDA to Cleveland-Cliffs Weirton LLC is authorized in the maximum amount of \$50,000,000 to finance its High Impact Development Project to produce materials and products to be utilized in the production of electrical transformers located in Weirton, West Virginia.

There being no further business, Mr. Wilmoth moved that the meeting be adjourned. The motion was seconded by Mr. Irby and without objection the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
