GENERAL SESSION

Morla Capital Finance, LLC - Equipment Loan Application

A motion was made by Mr. Hartley to approve a 10-year Equipment Loan to Morla Capital Finance, LLC in the amount of \$2,000,000 and a \$250,000 10-year Direct Loan to Morla Capital Finance, LLC. The motion was seconded by Mr. Irby and unanimously carried.

WHEREAS, the board determined that the public purpose of the West Virginia Economic Development Authority Act would be met by a loan in the amount of \$2,000,000 Equipment Loan and a \$250,000 Direct Loan to Morla Capital Finance, LLC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the loan request to Morla Capital Finance, LLC in the total amount of \$2,250,000 is given preliminary approval.

Clear Mountain Bank on behalf of The Bullock Distillery, LLC-Loan Insurance Modification

A motion was made by Mr. Ritchie to approve a Loan Insurance Modification as presented to Clear Mountain Bank on behalf of The Bullock Distillery, LLC. The motion was seconded by Mr. Hartley and unanimously carried.

Harrison County Economic Development Corporation - Loan Modification

A motion was made by Mr. Hartley to approve a loan modification to Harrison County Economic Development Corporation, increasing the loan amount from \$1,400,000 to \$1,880,485. The motion was seconded by Mr. Ritchie and unanimously carried.

Other Business

A. BEAD BLINS Program restriction of funds allocation

Ms. Workman from the West Virginia Department of Economic Development provided a summary of the Broadband Equity, Access and Deployment (BEAD) program, requesting the approval of an allocation of \$75 million as a restriction of funds, to financially support the Broadband Loan Insurance program, as support to the Broadband Equity, Access, and Deployment (BEAD) Program of the National Telecommunications and Information Administration (NTIA) being administered through the WV Office of Broadband.

A motion was made by Mr. Hartley to provisionally approve the allocation of \$75,000,000.00 pending the finalization of the NTIA BEAD Program and BLINS requirements. The motion was seconded by Mr. Irby and unanimously carried.

Jackie Browning left the meeting.

B. SafeCo Environmental, Inc. Contract Time Extension

Mr. Webb presented a request from SafeCo Environmental, Inc. for a contract time extension for the demolition, remediation and disposal of structures, fixtures, equipment, debris, waste, and other materials at the former Century Aluminum plant site located near Millwood in Jackson County, West Virginia now owned by the West Virginia Economic Development Authority.

A motion was made by Mr. Hartley to conditionally approve the time extension upon receipt of proper change order notices from SafeCo Environmental, Inc. The motion was seconded by Mr. Irby.

There being no further business, Mr. Ritchie moved that the meeting be adjourned. The motion was seconded by Mr. Irby and without objection the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
